

The public meets geology and social sciences researchers in field trips to hotspots of coastal erosion. The Portuguese west coast was particularly affected by violent storms during the last winter with significant damage to several beaches and economic impact. In September, these activities will be followed by debates with local authorities and stakeholders.


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
